July 11, 2021- Amos 7:12-15; Ephesians 1:3-14; Mark 6:7-13

Go forth in bold confidence! - *Good News Reflection*

In this Sunday's Gospel passage, Jesus teaches us about trust. If we're to fulfill our calling as God's missionaries of love in this world, if we're to fulfill our calling to share the Good News, we must trust God and the resources that he provides.

And we must trust that he will always provide exactly what we need when we need it, even though it doesn't always seem sufficient. It's important that we don't feed the inclination to distrust him by expecting anything other than what he provides.

Every Mass ends with a re-commissioning rite for the calling we all have. The final blessing is a sending forth after we've been renewed in our relationship with Jesus. His presence in the Word and in the Eucharist and in the Church community re-energizes us (when we pay attention) to boldly go and do all that he asks of us.

Through the priest, Jesus sends us into the world to be the visible proof that he is real and that he's alive and that he cares. With Jesus, and in him and through him, we are all evangelizers who can make a difference in the world.

Yes, all of us -- all of us who have participated in the Eucharistic celebration with conscious awareness of what we are saying and praying and receiving during Mass. Go forth in bold confidence! Jesus is sending you out from the church with his Spirit and his sufficiency.

However, when we do the packing and decide what to take with us on the mission, we like to take an abundance of stuff, just in case we might need it. Thus, we fail to show others that God is reliable and trustworthy.

To be effective evangelizers, we have to surrender over to God whatever baggage interferes with our mission.

Remember this: Surrender is not truly surrender unless we no longer want what we surrendered. If we still have some desire for it, we're attached to it by a bungee cord that yanks us back to it, yanking us away from our true purpose in life.

Beloved Jesus: Thank you for entrusting to me the precious treasure of Your Word for taking to my neighbors. Increase my faith in You so that, whatever the results, You are my support, my safety and my peace. Amen.

BAPTISMAL REQUIREMENTS You can also find the baptismal requirements at

(newborns-6 years of age)

1. **REGISTRATION.** The family must be registered -form on file- in St. Mary's for no less than 2 months before the Baptism takes place.
 - If parents are registered somewhere else, they must present a Letter of Permission from their parish priest in order for the child to be baptized here.
2. **PRE-BAPTISMAL TALK.** The Parents and godparents (sponsors) must have attended the pre-baptismal talk before the date of baptism.

3. **SPONSORS.** Sponsors must be registered at a Catholic Parish, be practicing Catholics, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. If any of the Sponsors are living together as a couple, he/she must have been married in the Roman Catholic Church.
4. **DOCUMENTS.** Bring COPIES of:
 - Child's Birth Certificate
 - Sponsor's Sacramental Certificates
 - Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation (or Marriage in case he/she is living with a significant other)

IMPORTANT.... DOCUMENT REQUESTS TO ST. MARY'S

Do you need a Sponsor Certificate/letter for either Baptism or Confirmation, a letter for Immigration, Membership, any type of Recommendation letter, or document? We must have your registration/census ON FILE for at least 2 months prior to your request.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Brothers and Sisters in the Lord,

We are a people who want to know the grace and peace of the Lord in our homes, hearts, streets, neighborhoods and nation. In order to encounter and live the peace of Jesus in these places we can open our hearts and hands to offer words, gestures and actions of peace and peacemaking. To know the peace of Christ is to know that we are in our God's hands and that nothing can separate us from the love of Christ. We become people of confident trust that all can be well when we align the direction of our lives to embrace all that is right, just, good, pleasing and perfect (in our love of God and our brothers and sisters). Receiving and offering the peace of Christ at every daily and Sunday Mass simply reminds us that we can offer signs of the Risen Lord's presence to one another. I would like to update the parish community on a few ongoing projects. The first, is contracting for a security system specifically in the Parish office area. Nearly three years ago I advocated for a parish center security system, but due to many factors, notwithstanding the Covid shut down, a system never materialized. Either this week or next a real security system will be put in place to protect the office areas of Ana, and the priests. While the security system is not extensive it can offer a new administration an opportunity to expand it for the larger Center.

Second, I have also contracted for a new parish photo directory. Much has happened in the industry as well as in the parish since the last one was done for St. Mary's in 2003. Why now might you ask before I leave? My reasons are simple. It not only updates a picture directory of those who are in the parish, but it also will provide a tool for Fr. Jack and the priests assigned to St. Mary's to identify people's faces and names. I've been assured that people will have the opportunity that will respect the privacy of those who participate either by simply having their family or single picture without any identifying information or only names and no picture. I can only hope that this can bring our parish community a bit closer when we come to know the names of our brothers and sisters who worship and serve at St. Mary's. This photo directory project, however, requires a great deal of organization and advertisement on the part of a few members willing to engage in the project. **I am asking for a few volunteers from each of racial, cultural and language groups to offer their time and service.** This is purely voluntary. My hope is that a committee can be formed and informed by the Universal Photo Directory Company. I realize that summer is tricky to commit time and energy, but if you are interested, please contact the parish office at 336-272-8650. I will also be asking for some additional volunteers in person.
