OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE

November 23th, 2025- 2 Sm 5:1-3, Col 1:12-20, Lk 23:35-43

Christ Reigns with Love. The Solemnity of Christ the King Year C reminds us that Jesus is the true King. His rule is not about power or wealth. It is about love, mercy, and peace. He leads us by giving His life for us. This feast helps us see what real kingship means in God's eyes.

On this day, we remember that Jesus is the head of all creation. Everything belongs to Him. Yet He chooses to care for us as a shepherd cares for his sheep. The Solemnity of Christ the King Year C calls us to follow His way of kindness and service.

This feast also gives us hope. Christ's kingdom is not broken or temporary. It is forever, and He invites us to be part of it. When we live in His love, we share in the joy of His kingdom, both now and in the life to come.

Lord, we thank you that you showed us in Jesus the true meaning of power. He exercised kingship by coming among us as a companion, sharing our terrible experiences of lowliness, of hanging on a cross with two criminals, one on our right and the other on our left, having people jeer at us that we who are your anointed, specially chosen by you, we who in many ways bring salvation to others, are unable to save ourselves or our families.

Now we can share with you the pain of having those who looked up to us as leaders in the community angry with us because we could not save them, we could not even save ourselves. Give us the grace to follow in Jesus' footsteps, turning our moments of lowliness into moments of power, when we enter into communion with those in need, proving the values of the world wrong, for when we learn to accept that we cannot save ourselves, we bring salvation to all those who are being crucified.



BAPTISMAL REQUIREMENTS You can also find the baptismal requirements at https://stmarysgreensboro.org/sacrements/ (newborns-6 years of age)

- REGISTRATION. The family must be registered -form on filefor no less than 2 months before the Baptism takes place (6 months starting on January 1st, 2026).
 - If parents are registered somewhere else, they must present a Letter of Permission from their pastor in order for the child to be baptized here.
- PRE-BAPTISMAL TALK. The Parents and godparents (sponsors) must have attended a pre-baptismal talk before the date of baptism.
- 3. **SPONSORS**. Sponsors must be registered at a Catholic Parish, be practicing Catholics, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. If any of the Sponsors are living together as a couple, he/she must have been married in the Roman Catholic Church.
- 4. **DOCUMENTS.** Bring <u>COPIES</u> of:
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Pre-Baptismal Talk Certificate (Parents & Sponsors)
- Sponsor's Sacramental Certificates (Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation or only Marriage in case he/she is living with a significant other)

During this time, families will receive a **box of envelopes**. These are not only for contributions but also a simple way to help us record your participation at Mass—even if you are not able to contribute financially.
