December 7th, 2025– Is 11:1-10, Rom 15:4-9, Mt 3:1-12

Family Connection. We do many things to get ourselves ready for our celebration of Christmas: purchase gifts, prepare Christmas cards, decorate our homes. John's call of repentance in preparation for Jesus reminds us that our repentance is another way in which we can prepare for the Lord's coming and our celebration of Christmas.

Parish communities often offer a communal celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation during the Advent season. Your family might choose to participate in the communal celebration of the sacrament, or you might seek out the sacrament on an individual basis.

Read together today's Gospel. Talk about how John reminds the people that they prepare for the reign of God by reforming their lives. As a family, prepare a simple reconciliation service in preparation for Christmas such as the following: Gather in a prayerful space, perhaps around your family Advent wreath. Read again today's Gospel: Matthew 3:1-3. Invite each family member to pray silently, asking God to forgive their sins. Pray together an Act of Contrition. Then celebrate God's forgiveness by sharing a Sign of Peace with each other.

BAPTISMAL REQUIREMENTS You can also find the baptismal requirements at https://stmarysgreensboro.org/sacrements/ (newborns-6 years of age)

- REGISTRATION. The family must be registered -form on filefor no less than 2 months before the Baptism takes place (6 months starting on January 1st, 2026).
 - If parents are registered somewhere else, they must present a Letter of Permission from their pastor in order for the child to be baptized here.
- PRE-BAPTISMAL TALK. The Parents and godparents (sponsors) must have attended a pre-baptismal talk before the date of baptism.
- 3. **SPONSORS**. Sponsors must be registered at a Catholic Parish, be practicing Catholics, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. If any of the Sponsors are living together as a couple, he/she must have been married in the Roman Catholic Church.
- 4. **DOCUMENTS.** Bring COPIES of:
- Child's Birth Certificate
- Pre-Baptismal Talk Certificate (Parents & Sponsors)

 Sponsor's Sacramental Certificates (Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation or only Marriage in case he/she is living with a significant other)
