THIRD SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

January 25th, 2026– Is 8:23—9:3, 1 Cor 1:10-13, 17, Mt 4:12-23

In the second reading today (1 Corinthians:10-13, 17), Saint Paul calls for unity in the community in believing and preaching one message, the Gospel of Jesus Christ. The Gospel is “the Christian good news of Jesus Christ and his victory over the forces of evil, sin, and death by his resurrection.” (Living With Christ, January 2026, page 174)

In the Gospel today (Matthew 4:12-23), Jesus calls a group of men, the Apostles, to join him in proclaiming that the “Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.” (Matthew 4:17) Again, good news that they will continue to proclaim after Jesus’ death and resurrection in preaching, by word and deed, the Gospel.

Today is also the Foundation Day for the Congregation of the Mission, the Vincentians; the Community of Brothers and Priests founded by Saint Vincent De Paul to preach the Gospel, by word and deed, to the Poor. We are the Brothers and Priests who minister at Saint Mary’s. Our loving God has called all of us, Parishioners, Brothers, and Priests, as members of the Vincentian Family to preach the Gospel; especially to those who are poor, struggling, and marginalized. Let us give thanks to God for that call.

BAPTISMAL REQUIREMENTS You can also find the baptismal requirements at <https://stmarysgreensboro.org/sacraments/> (newborns-6 years of age)

1. **REGISTRATION.** The family must be registered -form on file- for no less than 6 months before the Baptism.

- If parents are registered somewhere else, they must present a Letter of Permission from their pastor in order for the child to be baptized here.
2. **PRE-BAPTISMAL TALK.** The Parents and godparents (sponsors) must have attended a pre-baptismal talk before the date of baptism.
 3. **SPONSORS.** Sponsors must be registered at a Catholic Parish, be practicing Catholics, and must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion, and Confirmation. If any of the Sponsors are living together as a couple, he/she must have been married in the Roman Catholic Church.
 4. **DOCUMENTS.** Bring COPIES of:
 - Child's Birth Certificate
 - Pre-Baptismal Talk Certificate (Parents & Sponsors)
 - Sponsor's Sacramental Certificates (Baptism, First Communion & Confirmation or only Marriage in case he/she is living with a significant other).

HOW TO BECOME A REGISTERED MEMBER OF ST MARY'S? Families and individuals age 21 and over are warmly invited to register. Visit the parish office to complete a form and receive envelopes at **no cost**. Official membership is recognized after **six months** of active parish participation.

IMPORTANT.... **DOCUMENT REQUESTS TO ST. MARY'S**

Do you need a Sponsor Certificate/letter for either Baptism or Confirmation, a letter for Immigration, Membership, any type of Recommendation letter, or document? We must have your registration/census ON FILE for at least 6 months prior to your request.

TO ALL ST. MARY VOLUNTEERS



All parishioners who volunteer in a group or ministry are required by the Diocese of Charlotte to have a **CMGConnect account**.

The CMG platform provides: (1) **Training** for volunteers who have contact with minors and vulnerable adults. (2) **Policies and guidelines** for volunteers who do not work directly with minors or vulnerable adults.
